Twenty at-risk boys and girls gained a new friend when they were matched with a Big Brother, Big Sister, or classroom mentor, a program of FHN Family Counseling Center.

NICAA Golden Meals delivered nutritious meals to 62 seniors.

Two income-eligible individuals received free civil legal assistance from Prairie State Legal Services.

Fifteen boys learned various life skills and values through Boy Scouts - Blackhawk Area Council.

Amity Day Care and Learning Center provided an accredited, safe, learning environment for two children.

Assault and Abuse Services of Stephenson County provided support, intervention, education, and counseling to four victims of sexual assault.

Regional Access and Mobilization Project (RAMP) provided advocacy and services for two individuals with disabilities so they could maintain independent living.

Three income-eligible working parents received child care scholarships at the Family YMCA of Northwest Illinois.

Sojourn House's treatment programs and counseling services helped two individuals overcome addictions.

Tyler's Justice Center for Children provided program coordination and advocacy for six children who were abused and non-offending family members.
