The Workshop delivered one-on-one counseling and classes for 12 individuals with special needs.

Sojourn House's treatment programs and counseling services helped 33 individuals overcome addictions.

Thirty-four at-risk boys and girls gained a new friend when they were matched with a Big Brother, Big Sister, or classroom mentor, a program of FHN Family Counseling Center.

Over 75 boys learned various life skills and values through Boy Scouts - Blackhawk Area Council.

NICAA Golden Meals delivered nutritious meals to 68 seniors.

Senior Resource Center delivered information and follow-up to 103 seniors to assist them in maintaining an adequate income in retirement.

Six income-eligible individuals received free civil legal assistance from Prairie State Legal Services.

Rainbow Ridge provided a safe place to live, life-skills training, and services for 22 individuals with developmental disabilities.

Tyler's Justice Center for Children provided program coordination and advocacy for 40 children who were abused and non-offending family members.

New Horizons Counseling Center provided direction and hope to three individuals through their counseling services.

Neighborhood Housing Services helped a family achieve their dream of owning a home.
