Seventy-six boys learned various life skills and values through Boy Scouts - Blackhawk Area Council.

Three families were given aid and assistance from the American Red Cross after experiencing a disaster in their homes.

An at-risk boy gained a new friend when he was matched with a Big Brother, a program of FHN Family Counseling Center.

NICAA Golden Meals delivered nutritious meals to 113 seniors.

Ten teen mothers received incentives and education from Mother Hubbard's Kiddie Cupboard for prenatal care and immunizations.

Neighborhood Housing Services helped a family achieve their dream of owning a home.

Five income-eligible individuals received free civil legal assistance from Prairie State Legal Services.

Regional Access and Mobilization Project (RAMP) provided advocacy and services for nine individuals with disabilities so they could maintain independent living.

Senior Resource Center delivered information and follow-up to 174 seniors to assist them in maintaining an adequate income in retirement.

Eight families received food from the Salvation Army's Community Kitchen.

Four income-eligible working parents received child care scholarships at the Family Y.M.C.A. of Northwest Illinois.

VOICES Domestic Violence Program provided support and advocacy to 17 victims of domestic violence.

Assault and Abuse Services of Stephenson County provided support, intervention, education, and counseling to eight victims of sexual assault.
