Two income-eligible individuals received free civil legal assistance from Prairie State Legal Services.

Two families were given aid and assistance from the American Red Cross after experiencing a disaster in their homes.

Over 60 boys learned various life skills and values through Boy Scouts - Blackhawk Area Council.

Regional Access and Mobilization Project (RAMP) provided advocacy and services for ten individuals with disabilities so they could maintain independent living.
